### Membership Dues

To become / remain a member shall be \$50 annually per person or \$75 per married couple (which may be paid in installments). An investment of at least 10 hours of volunteer service may be made in lieu of dues. This volunteer service must be approved in advance by the membership committee or a representative whom they designate and must be documented by the same in writing and submitted with the minutes of the next membership committee meeting.

### If a board vacancy exists:

- 1. The membership of the organization shall be notified of upcoming Board vacancies no later than November 1<sup>st</sup> of each and every year.
- 2. Any eligible member of the organization who wishes to be considered for a Board position shall indicate his or her desire in writing to the Board, by sending a letter to the Corporate Office no later than December 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 3. All members wishing to be nominated who are eligible pursuant to the requirements of the bylaws shall have their names entered on a personalized member ballot which will be distributed by mail to all members by January 1<sup>st</sup> with a return requirement of February 1<sup>st</sup>.

### Annual Meeting

The Board will conduct an Annual Meeting the second Tuesday of February each calendar year. The Annual Meeting shall be open to all members.
